Song Stylist

Ms. Cosham is one of Washington DC's most popular song stylists and actresses. Her one-woman cabaret shows have received wide acclaim from coast to coast. *Washington Post* critic Mike Joyce reviewed her CD: "Cosham is a master at creating a warmly evocative mood, no matter how familiar the lyric or how common the sentiment."

She has performed on most of the stages in the Washington DC area and was nominated for a Helen Hayes award and two Washington Music awards. She has also appeared as a vocalist at numerous venues, including Blues Alley, The Folger Theatre, The Shakespeare Theatre, Lisner Auditorium, The Lyceum, The Arts Club of Washington, Atlas Performing Arts Center, and The World Bank.



She has been guest artist with the Fairfax City Band, The McLean Symphony, and The United States Navy Band Commodores. Ms. Cosham developed a Master Class, *Acting Up a Song*, which uses acting techniques to interpret song lyrics, has taught Improv for children, and has developed classes for the George Mason University Osher Lifelong Learning Institute. She has recorded three CDs and two LPs. Ms. Cosham not only serves as President of the RCO, she is Chair of the Reston Community Center's Board of Governors.
